What is GLIF?

- GLIF is an international virtual organisation that promotes the paradigm of lambda networking
- The activities of GLIF are two-fold:
 - GLIF participants jointly make lambdas available as an integrated global facility for use in data-intensive research
 - GLIF brings together leading networking engineers worldwide, who collaborate to bring the technology forward
- Secretariat functions for GLIF are provided by TERENA staff



1. Website:

- New GLIF website was created, hosted on server in TERENA Secretariat office (Gb/s)
- Information was moved from previous website
- Website was expanded with new sections
- More information was added to website
- Website is being updated regularly



2. Mailing lists:

- (Closed) mailing lists were created for GLIF working groups: tech@glif.is, controlplane@glif.is, rap@glif.is, gov@glif.is
- The list <u>all@glif.is</u> contains those subscribed to any
 of the above, plus additional people
- Additional lists were created to discuss the GLIF repository <u>repository@glif.is</u> and for operators of lambda exchanges <u>gole@glif.is</u>
- Approval of subscription requests and unsubscriptions are handled within hours

 - 5th Annual Global LambdaGrid Workshop San Diego, 29-30 September 2005
 - WG-TECH and WG-CP meetings
 Albuquerque, 8-9 February 2006
 - 6th Annual Global LambdaGrid Workshop Tokyo, 11-12 September 2006



4. Secretariat of GLIF working groups:

- For each WG a qualified secretary has been provided
- WG meetings were organised (logistics, agenda)
- Draft minutes and list of action items were produced
- Minutes and presentations were published on GLIF website
- Progress is being monitored and people are being reminded about action items



5. Maintain GLIF repository:

- Different technical approaches were investigated and discussed
- A standard nomenclature was developed and agreed
- GLIF resources are being identified and a repository of GOLEs and lambdas is maintained on the GLIF webpages, including contact information, interfaces and connectivity diagrams



6. Public relations and outreach:

- Press releases on the annual GLIF workshop and major developments in GLIF were published
- A GLIF brochure has not yet been produced: for discussion
