> Tech and Control WG reasons for existing

- - GLIF participants share a vision – in order to get there, we have to *actively* pursue the vision
- - the activity space is large / need some focus
 - Tech was divided into Tech and Control Plane
- - the Control folks are technical too! ;-)
 - Tech focus is provisioning global end-end LightPaths today
 - Ctrl focus is provisioning global end-end LightPaths tomorrow
- E.g. Tech will be updating infrastructure topology diagrams and talking about connectivity to SC '06
- E.g Ctrl will talk about strategies and technologies for the automation of interdomain provisioning of end-end LightPaths

> Interaction between Tech and Control

- - Tech could be renamed “Work Harder WG”
- (e.g. provision more end-end LightPaths by tweaking the 500 e-mails per LightPath system)
- - Ctrl could be renamed “Work Smarter WG”
- (e.g. let the ctrl plane do the work)
- - Luckily for Tech, once in a while Ctrl and Tech will be in the same room and we'll hear: “Tech – why don't you do it this way?”
And then we all go “Hum, yes Ctrl - great idea!”
 - And this is where it happens or gets started, i.e. in the joint sessions
