#### What is GLIF?

- GLIF is an international virtual organisation that promotes the paradigm of lambda networking
- The activities of GLIF are two-fold:
  - GLIF participants jointly make lambdas available as an integrated global facility for use in data-intensive research
  - GLIF brings together leading networking engineers worldwide, who collaborate to bring the technology forward
- Secretariat functions for GLIF are provided by TERENA staff



- 1. Website and mailing lists:
  - As requested in previous meeting, a clear link to "What is GLIF?" was made on home page
  - New maps were put on-line
  - More information was added to website
  - Website is being updated regularly
  - (Closed) mailing lists are maintained for GLIF working groups: tech@glif.is, controlplane@glif.is, rap@glif.is, gov@glif.is
  - The list <u>all@glif.is</u> contains those subscribed to any of the above, plus additional people
  - Additional lists exist to discuss the GLIF repository repository@glif.is and for operators of lambda exchanges gole@glif.is
  - Approvals of subscription requests and unsubscriptions are handled within hours

  - Minutes and presentations were published on GLIF website
  - Progress is being monitored and people are being reminded about action items
  - Number of changes in secretariat team; current team consists of Kevin Meynell, Péter Szegedi and Karel Vietsch



#### 4. GLIF resources:

- GLIF resources are identified and a repository of GOLEs and lambdas is maintained on the GLIF webpages, including contact information, interfaces and connectivity diagrams
- GOLE teleconferences have been discontinued (the new Task Forces form a new focus of activities)



5. Public relations and outreach:

- Press releases on the annual GLIF workshop and major developments in GLIF were published
- The small, glossy brochure was distributed at suitable events
