## **Internet Population in 2009**

Internet Users(First Billions):

~ 1.5 Billions

Non-Internet Users(The Other Billions):

~ 5 Billions

#### **Internet Population in 2020(Estimate)**

Internet Users: 3~5
 Billions

Non-Internet Users: 3~4
 Billions

#### Remark:

Internet Users will double or triple in ten years(2010~2020).

How do we harmonize the increase and green Internet?

### **Ground Rules**

Have as many Internet users as possible.

 Learn from the front runners, i.e., First Billions.

#### **Issue - Electric Power**

- Electricity Generation Quality
  - \* Avoid backup generators wherever/ whenever possible.
  - \* Try to use alternative electric power as appropriate.

- Electricity Quality
  - \* Try to have stable voltage, cycle,...
  - \* Minimize down time.

### **Issue - Battery**

 Need to develop appropriate batteries for The Other Billions.

 Need to consider environmentally friendly battery including recycling.
