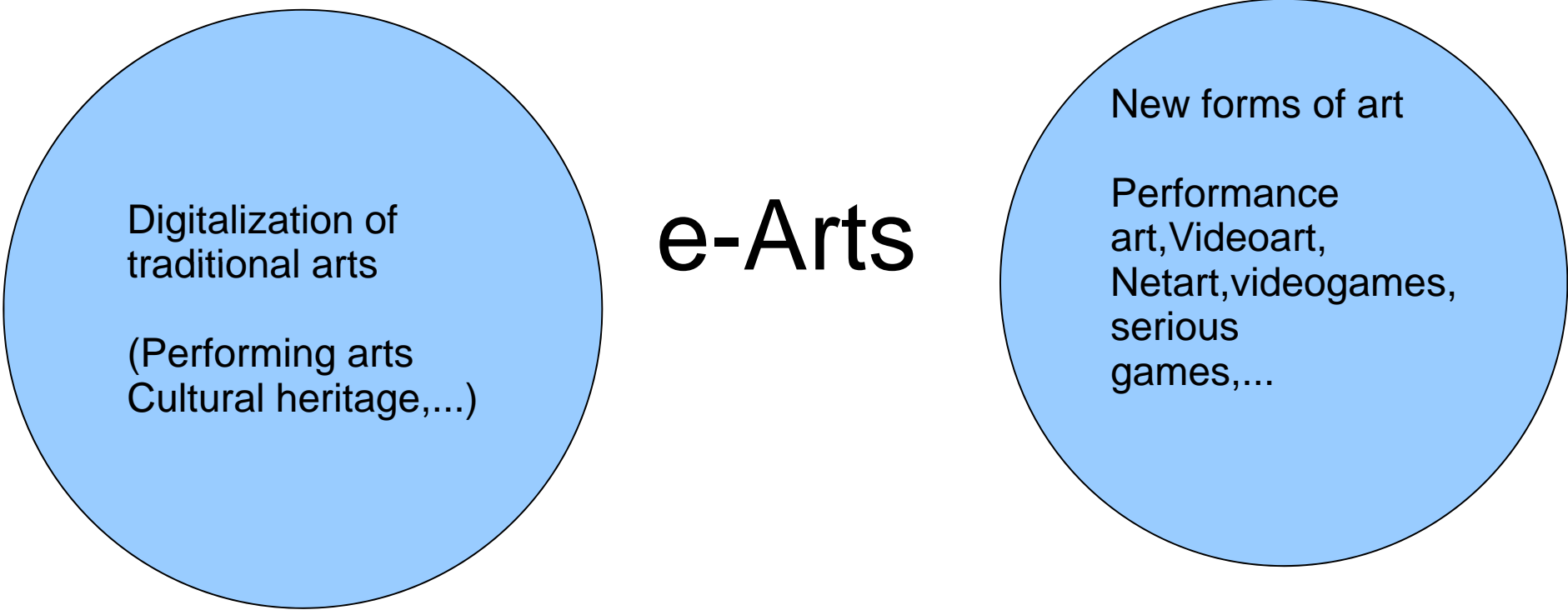
- 1st. 1970s-80s The Internet of the computer scientists and technological people (email,ftp,telnet,...) (6 M personas)

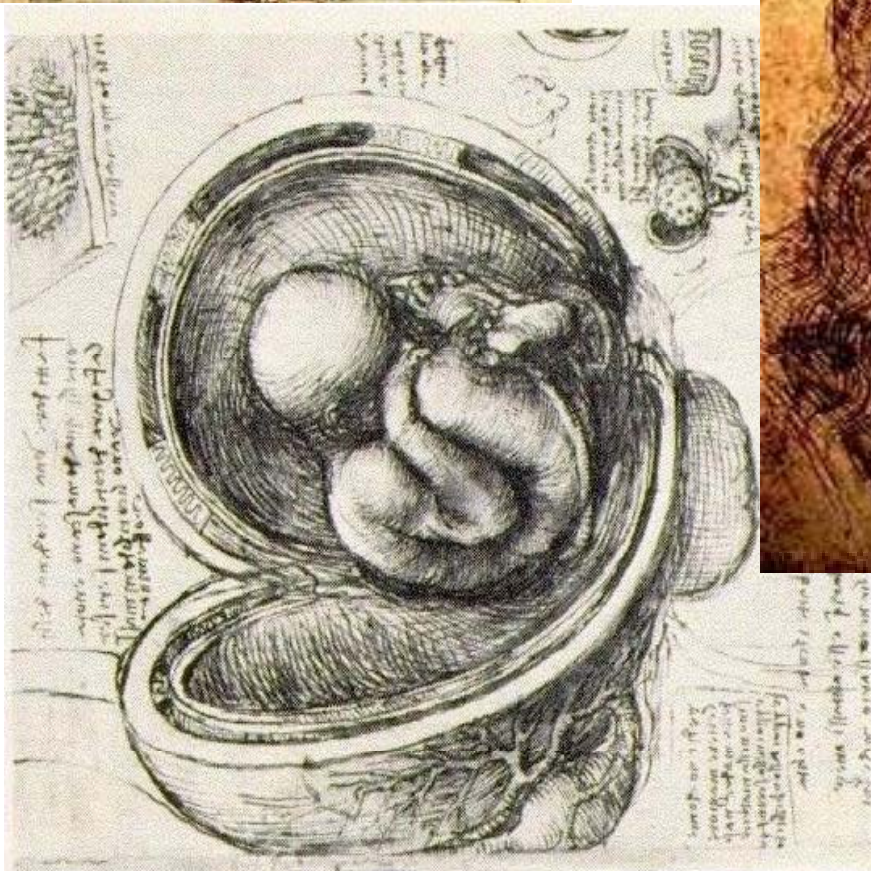
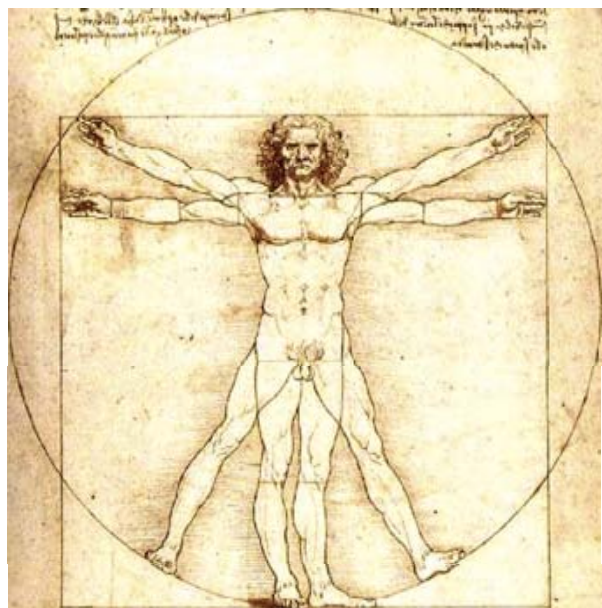

Internet2 & New World Symphony Performance and Master Class Production Workshop

Internet2 and the [New World Symphony](#) will host a hands-on audio/video production workshop on **25-27 January, 2010**, on the campus of the New World Symphony in Miami Beach, Florida. The workshop will include demonstrations, real-time experience connecting with remote sites over Internet2 advanced networks, collaborating and developing international partnerships and projects, and setting up incoming and outgoing audio and managing echo, creating a multi-camera shoot, placing lights and projectors and operating a variety of hardware and software codecs. We will explore in depth the elements needed to do everything from simple one-on-one interactions to larger scale stage productions, and will give participants an opportunity to gain hands-on experience with codecs and network testing tools, discuss dealing with variable bandwidth issues and the administrative and economic requirements to implement production.
