#### What do you think the major technical issues are with lightpath services on campus?

- Issues in part campus edge and end user
  - Not enough available bandwidth
  - No domain controller, must support variety of equipment
  - Lack of integration, campus not designed for BoD
  - Campus NOC needs to provide service for only a few users
  - Security issues, operational procedures difficult
- Outdated infra, ill managed equipment and provisioning
- Extra cost to network infrastructure



### What do you think the major non-technical issues are with lightpath services on campus?

- Organisation
  - Convince management to support BoD
  - Coordinate with various stakeholders at the campus
  - Alignment with local business and technical strategy
  - Alignment with local policies
  - Campus networkers do not always speak English
- Security concerns
- Spend time and money on new service, who gets the bill?
- Promote BoD to high end users



#### Further remarks

- It may be helpful to provide some examples as a GLIF document so that the user can negotiate with his/her campus networking engineers to provide a lightpath.
- I would like to share best practices with both a technical and non-technical focus of lightpath needing projects.
- I see GLIF promoted as an infrastructure (at the setup and some years after that also) it was not seen as an infrastructure, but as a cooperation of networks. So something has changed?
