Purpose of Resource Allocation Task Force

- What does the user want to know about Endpoints?
 - Determine what high-end resources are available for researchers globally - High Voltage Electron Microscope, Storage, etc.
 - Determine resource characteristics, IP Address, Termination point technology, NREN, GOLEs, cost
 - Determine required configuration parameters
 - Determine policy of resource

- wiki on GLIF site – centralized not very searchable?
- Independent server registration at a central point?
