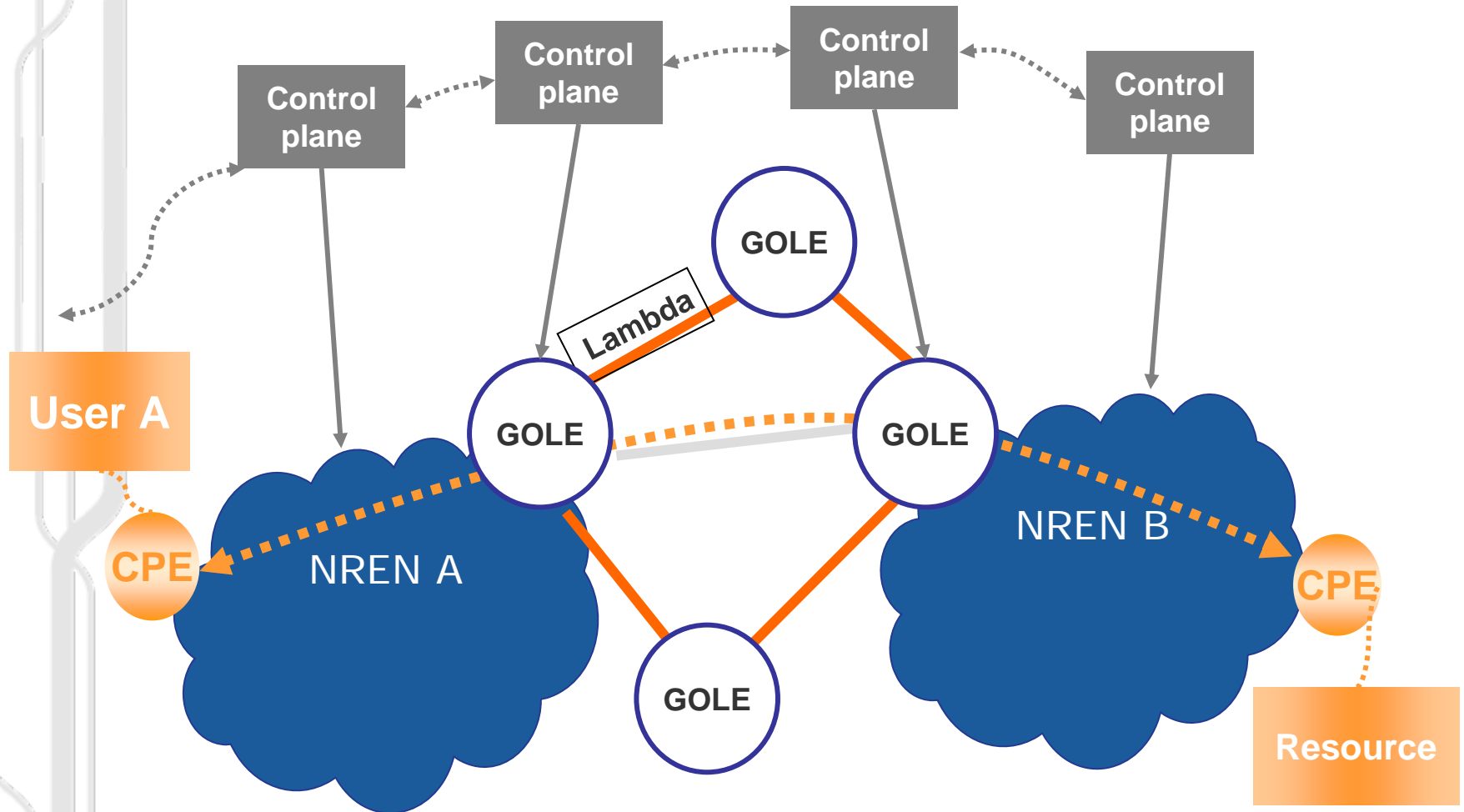


Chicago, 11-12 October 2012

- Global Lambda Integrated Facility
 - It's not a network
 - It's not really a facility
 - It's all about ideas, sharing, and participation
 - It's all about personal networking
 - It's all about having consensus on an architecture for research networking
 - It's all about enabling important things to happen



GOLE-centric networking



- GOLE Updates
 - Advanced, global e-science projects
 - Bringing it to the campus
 - Enabling (commercial) service providers
 - GÉANT Open
- Defining GLIF architecture
 - Charter approved; High-level, multi-layer architecture put forward as starting point for discussion
- GreenSONAR
 - How do we know our actual carbon footprint?
 - PerfSONAR-like mechanism for measuring carbon footprint
 - Strong interest and support from GLIF TECH



- SDN – implications for GLIF
 - The context in which the GLIF is operating is changing
 - The window for influencing the direction of technologies may be short
 - GLIF TECH as home for global stitching experiments
- Next step: Inter-domain SDN Taskforce
 - Focused & Fast – give feedback to vendors while the window is open
 - Charter and initial results by January
 - Feeds into Defining GLIF Architecture taskforce
