What's Happening?

- Internet2 along with universities and NRENs in the Arabian Gulf region have been discussing how to improve global connectivity for the region.
- Recently NYU Abu Dhabi moved the activity along by committing jointly with Internet2 to fund connectivity to Singapore from the region.



Community Actions

- A parallel working group has been drafting a 'white paper' advocating the creation of an Open Exchange Point in the Gulf. Called AGE-OX, the proposed site is Fujairah, UAE.
 - Fujairah is a landing station in the region for multiple submarine cables.
- Objective of paper is to be a resource for local NRENs, Universities & research institutes seeking to create their own business case for connectivity to the Global Internet.




Status

- Most of the base agreements are done or will be very shortly.
- A hardware RFP is nearly done.
 - It will be issued by Ankabut.
- Circuit Status:
 - Planning on a 2.5G circuit.
 - Should be ordered soon.
- Planned date for operation is mid to late December.
