Atlanta, 20 March 2014

- Global Lambda Integrated Facility
 - It's not a network
 - It's not really a facility
 - It's all about ideas, sharing, and participation
 - It's all about personal networking
 - It's all about having consensus on an architecture for research networking
 - It's all about enabling important things to happen



- NSI2.0 Update
 - the standard is out there
- AutoGOLE TF
 - There's a clear workplan for 2014
 - Topology exchange demos
- Performance Verification TF
 - Discussed architecture & automated diagnostics
 - Roadmap for PerfSONAR
 - Proposal for trial w/PerfSONAR-enabled GOLEs
- SDN TF
 - Presentation of (single-domain) SDN efforts Esnet, Internet2, SURFnet
 - Discussion of multi-domain issues
 - Suggestion of GLIF effort in creating multi-network SDN testbed. SDN-enabled GOLEs?



- GLIF Architecture TF
 - Discussion of near- and long-term objectives of GLIF architecture work.
 - What do we want to achieve together in GLIF? Deploy, Operate, Experiment, Develop, or something else?
 - How to update GOLE definitions from what it was 10 years ago
 - Focus on GOLEs, networks, service abstractions, applications?
- Network Virtualization
 - Presentation of (different) approaches in Internet2, GEANT.
 - Discussion of how GLIF can contribute
 - Suggestion that GLIF help define a standard way to ask for resources across testbeds, w/uniform service definition.



- NSI Implementation
 - Presentation of Authorization implementation in SURFnet, RPN
 - Extensive discussion of authentication implementations
 - Hands-on discussion and comparison of approaches to NSI CS 2.0 implementation and related issues by groups actively implementing NSI-based BoD services



The Big Picture

- Much to do – and plenty of ideas in the room for how GLIF TECH can contribute
 - SDN Taskforce – Global SDN-GOLE fabric
 - Performance Verification Taskforce
 - Production PerfSONAR taskforce
 - GLIF Architecture Taskforce & GNA
 - OLE Operator coordination
- However, we must be clear on
 - How we do this – together
 - How we create actionable workplans that we will result in work between meetings
- There's great stuff being done
 - NSI implementation
 - AutoGOLE
 - ... and I hope we can replicate that in other areas



Actions

- Initiate Global PerfSONAR Production activity
- Investigate option for GLIF SDN Testbed interconnection activity
- Continue discussion of network virtualization approaches; investigate trial for global resource request broker
- Re-activate GLIF Operator Forum – probably with monthly calls
- Clarify relation between GLIF TECH and Global Network Architectures
- Clarify workplan for GLIF Architecture Taskforce
