Services

End to End service delivery,
Through Nexuses

- Deterministic Services:
 - Guaranteed BW Service
 - Guaranteed BW Service with Pre-empting
- Non-deterministic Services:
 - Best Effort Service
 - Flow Service
- Other Services:
 - Special Use

High level stuff

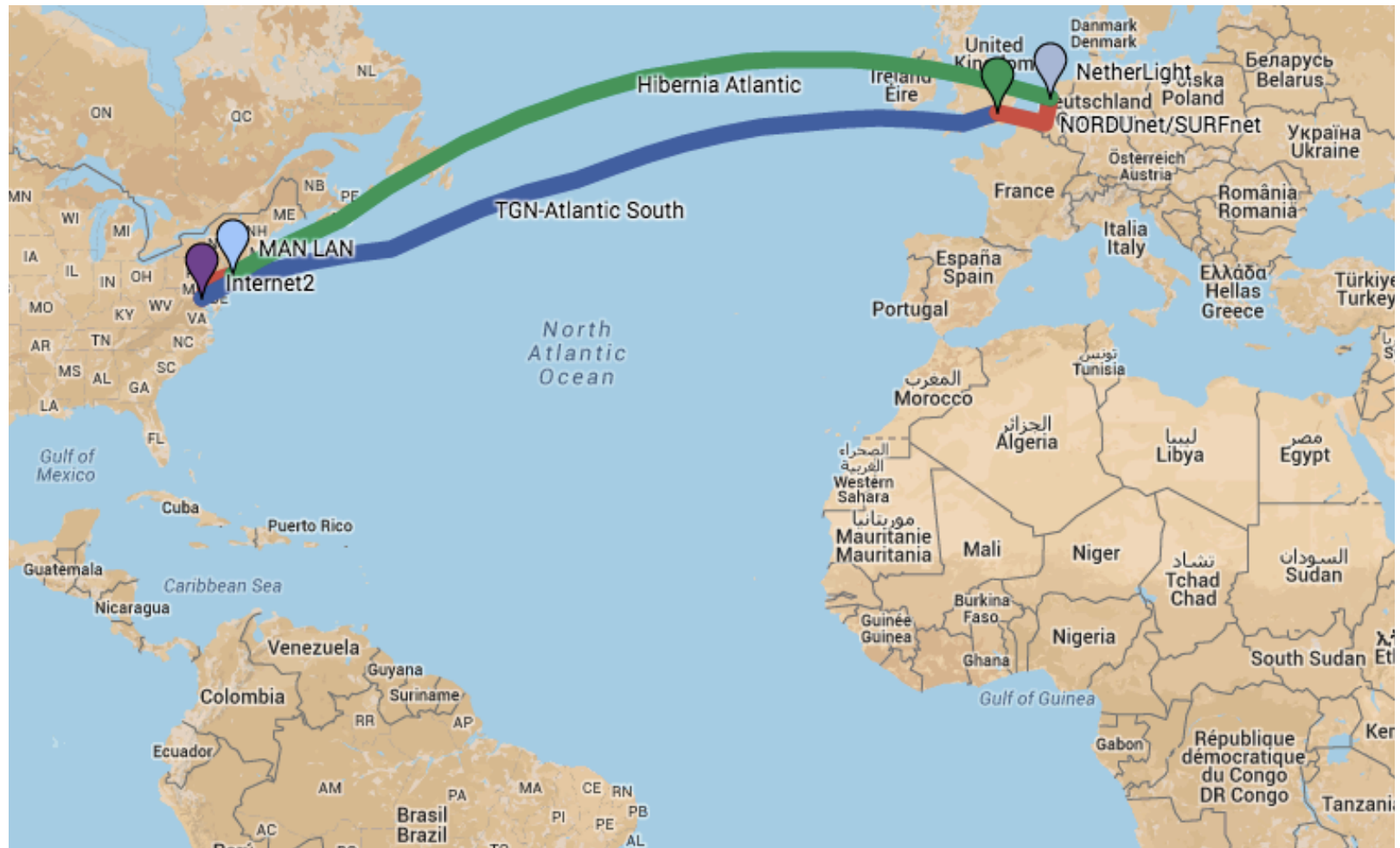


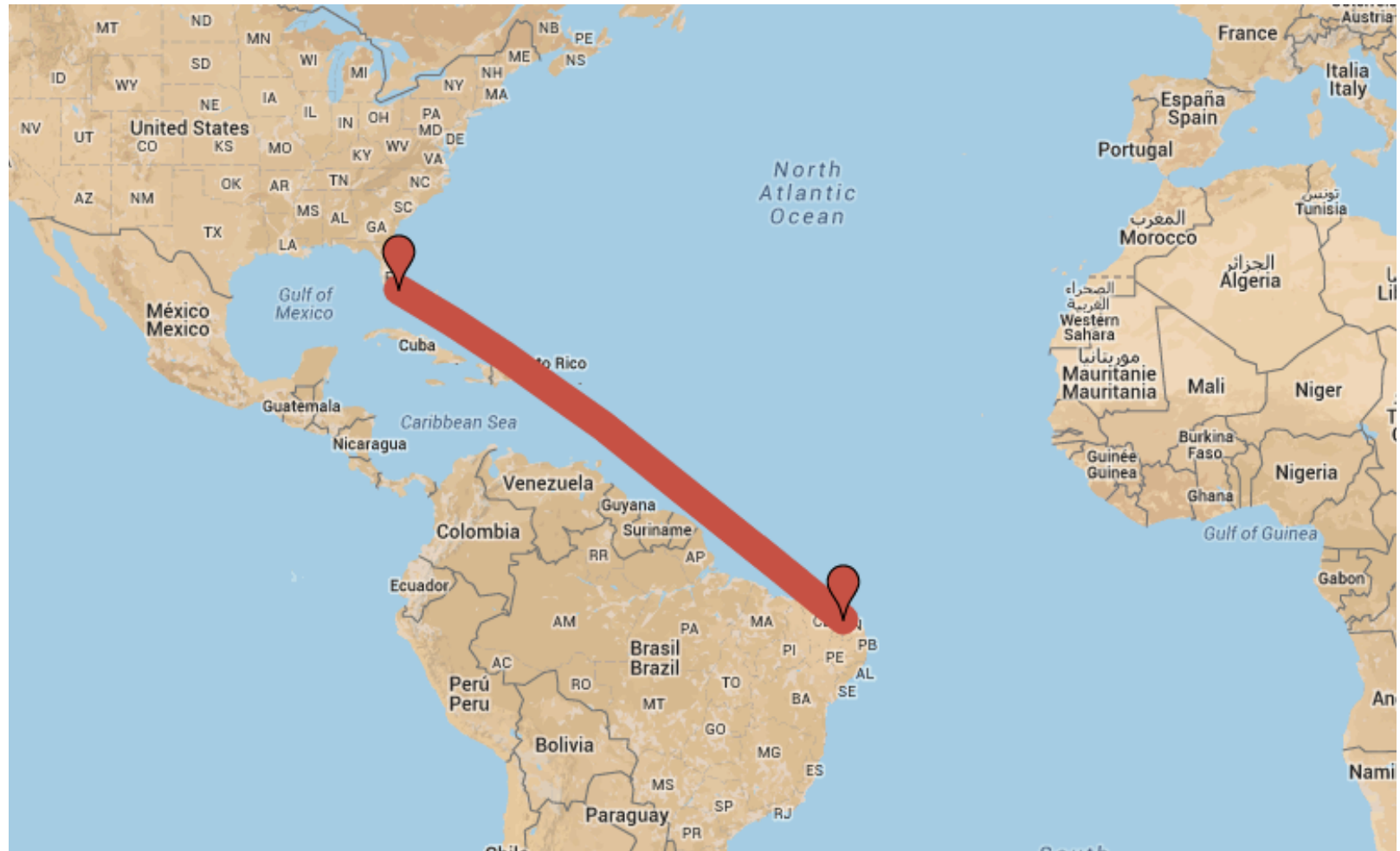
- Point-to-point Anywhere-in-the-World
- Multi-point service A-i-t-W
- Overlay services (like LHCONE):
 - L2
 - L3
 - MDVPN
 - Content peering

- Monitoring & Trouble tickets
 - (flowing back along provisioning lines across multiple networks / verification)
- Tie into Compute & Tie into Storage
 - (as part of the L3 overlay / towards CDN service & caching)
- Slicing (of OSS)
- Encryption & Certification on transport layer (P2P / P2MP / Overlay)
- Security Services / Forensics / Boundary DDoS mitigation

- Verification of Services
- Automation as much as possible
- High-availability (resiliency)
- Version Management
